**Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December: Christmas dress up “make a memory” day.** We would like to invite pupils to come into school in either a Christmas Jumper or themed in a Christmas outfit etc. Our classrooms will be decorated, and we will take a photograph of your child with a Christmas backdrop. For pupils on packed lunches, we have noticed that parents are wanting to send warm options. We understand this, especially with us needing to keep the windows open. **The best option for a warm meal is a in-school lunch; these are warm food options suited to eating in the classroom (i.e. not liquid or scalding hot).**

We do need to ensure that children are not at risk of scalding due to hot food. For that reason, please see the following guidance around school packed lunches:

Lunch time staff do not routinely touch and open pupil packed lunches, particularly in the current pandemic. Be sure that your child can manage what has been put in their lunch box.

Packed lunches **should not** contain:

**Hot liquids (soups, drinks etc.).** These can spill and scald, and many children do not know how to open and seal the containers properly. Even if your child is safe, think about the children sitting next to them.

Packed lunches **can** contain warm foods if they are:

Food stuffs that do not spill and spread (e.g. non-liquid) e.g. pasta which has been kept in an insulated thermos style container, warmed sausage roll / pasty wrapped in foil etc. If it is hot and likely to spill and spread, please don't send it in.

We will keep this under review, we hope this will work for parents and families.

### **Free School Meal vouchers over the Christmas period**

In order to receive a voucher over the Christmas period you must ensure the school has your correct email address. Please check this before we break up. There will be no staff in work over the Christmas period to help you once we close.

### **Sanitiser and soap**

We know that the regular handwashing routine can be a challenge for us all, and especially children with soft and sensitive skin. We are required to have a regular hand washing and sanitising routine to keep everyone safe. You are welcome to provide hand sanitiser of your choosing and hand crème for your child if you so wish. Please inform your child's class teacher if you do so and be aware that your child is required to look after it.
