School is closed Monday 1st May and Monday 8th May due to bank holidays.

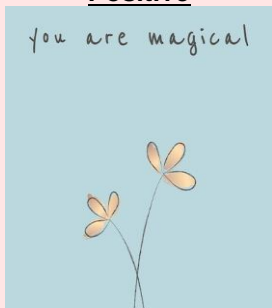
School will also be closed on Thursday 4th May due to Inset day
